## DAVID CHIPPERFIELD

SINCE THE FOUNDING OF HIS FIRM 30 YEARS AGO, BRITISH ARCHITECT DAVID CHIPPERFIELD HAS ACHIEVED INTERNATIONAL RENOWN FOR HIS BODY OF WORK IN THE CULTURAL, RESIDENTIAL, CIVIC, AND COMMERCIAL REALMS.

RECENT CROWNING ACHIEVEMENTS INCLUDE THE REVITALIZATION OF BERLIN'S NEUE MUSEUM, THE RESTORATION OF MIES VAN DER ROHE'S NEUE NATIONALE GALERIE, AND SIMPLE, ELEGANT DESIGNS FOR NEW MUSEUM BUILDINGS — LARGE AND SMALL — IN THE UNITED KINGDOM, EUROPE, AND NORTH AMERICA.

AMONG HIS NEW YORK PROJECTS IS THE RECENTLY COMPLETED 34 STORY APARTMENT BUILDING OVERLOOKING BRYANT PARK, WHICH SEAMLESSLY BLENDS WITH THE TRADITIONAL ARCHITECTURE OF ITS NEIGHBORS AND HIS STRIKING VALENTINO STORE ON FIFTH AVENUE.

SOANE FOUNDATION HONORS ARE AWARDED ANNUALLY TO THOSE WHO EXEMPLIFY SIR JOHN SOANE — HIS CREATIVE GENIUS, HIS REVERENCE FOR THE PAST, HIS MASTERY OF SPACE. IT IS PARTICULARLY FITTING TO BESTOW THIS YEAR'S AWARD ON DAVID CHIPPERFIELD, NOT ONLY FOR HIS ARCHITECTURAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS, BUT FOR HIS VALUED SERVICE AS THE ROYAL ACADEMY OF ART'S APPOINTEE TO THE SOANE MUSEUM BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

## AMY MEYERS

UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF ART HISTORIAN AMY MEYERS, THE YALE CENTER FOR BRITISH ART — HOUSING THE PAUL MELLON COLLECTION — HAS BECOME ONE OF THE FOREMOST DESTINATIONS IN THE WORLD FOR THE STUDY OF BRITISH ART AND CULTURE.

DURING HER FIFTEEN YEAR TENURE, DR. MEYERS HAS CREATED A ROBUST RESEARCH AND EDUCATION PROGRAM, ATTRACTING SCHOLARS FROM AROUND THE WORLD AND AT THE SAME TIME, SHE HAS OPENED THE DOORS OF THE CENTER TO A LARGE, DIVERSE AUDIENCE.

ONE OF HER MOST ENDURING CONTRIBUTIONS IS THE CONSERVATION AND REVITALIZATION OF THE LANDMARK BUILDING DESIGNED BY ARCHITECT LOUIS KAHN FOR THE CENTER'S COLLECTIONS. WITH METICULOUS ATTENTION TO KAHN'S DESIGN, SHE GUIDED THE PROJECT THROUGH THREE STAGES OF CONSERVATION, ENSURING THE CENTER'S OUTSTANDING COLLECTIONS HAVE A BEFITTING HOME.

THIS YEAR'S SOANE FOUNDATION HONORS TO DR. MEYERS CAPTURE THE SPIRIT OF A LADY WHO IS BOTH A HIGHLY RESPECTED HISTORIAN IN HER OWN RIGHT AND ONE WHO SO VIVIDLY PORTRAYS THE IMPORTANCE OF COLLABORATION AMONG COLLEAGUES AND INSTITUTIONS. HER ASSOCIATION WITH SIR JOHN SOANE'S MUSEUM IS LONG, RICH, AND DEEP.

## SIR JOHN SOANE'S MUSEUM

SIR JOHN SOANE ENJOYED A LONG DISTINGUISHED CAREER AS AN ARCHITECT, TEACHER AND COLLECTOR. WHEN HE DIED AT AGE 84 IN 1837, HE LEFT HIS LONDON HOME, LOCATED AT LINCOLN'S INN FIELDS, TO THE NATION. SIR JOHN SOANE'S MUSEUM IS INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNIZED AS THE BEST HOUSE-MUSEUM IN THE WORLD. IT IS A MASTERPIECE — WHERE IDEAS, FORM, FUNCTION, LIGHT AND SPACE BLEND TO CREATE A MAGICAL HARMONY — OR AS SOANE HIMSELF DESCRIBED IT, "THE POETRY OF ART AND ARCHITECTURE."
